League Details

- Play your league round any time during the scheduled week.

- ❖ League players must play one 9-hole round to establish a handicap.
 - ❖ Week 1 will be a handicapping round.
- Players that do not obtain a handicap will start the season with a 0 handicap.
 - ❖ All points awarded will be based on each individual's net score.
- Points will be awarded for first through last place each week. No points will be awarded to teams missing a week.

Registration Deadline

Teams must be registered, and the first round completed by February 11. If you are without a partner, we will take your name and do our best to find a teammate for you.

\$20 per player one-time league entry fee (\$40 per team). A reduced rate of \$20 per hour will be charged when playing your league round each week.

League Rules

The course, course set-up, and conditions each week will be listed and must be adopted by each golfer to keep play consistent.

NO MULLIGANS may be used unless there is a machine malfunction. Please see the HBC staff for assistance with these features.

If you or your partner will be gone an entire week(s), you may play your round(s) ahead. NO MAKE-UP ROUNDS will be permitted.

After completion of each round, scorecards are to be turned in to HBC staff.

Please be ready to play at your scheduled time. Nine holes for two people should take approximately 1 – 1.5 hours. If your team exceeds your scheduled time, you will be charged for the next half hour. We appreciate everyone being aware of the tight scheduling needed to get everyone's round in during the week.
